Virginia DECA's ICDC Bingo

Universal Theme Parks

- Universal has three awesome theme parks open to all DECA ICDC attendees! Some of the attractions include the Wizarding World of Harry Potter, the Hollywood Rip Ride Rockit (where you choose your own music to play for the ride – unique to you!!), and so many more. There are several ticketing options available through DECA for Universal Studios Park, Universal Islands of Adventure, and Universal Volcano Bay.
- DECA Night at Universal is another great way to attend the parks. From 6-11 pm one night, the park is closed to DECA ICDC attendees only. Tickets are now sold out, but your chapter can join a waiting list if you have not already purchased tickets.

Disney World Theme Parks

- Disney World is also a great option! Each park has its own unique attractions, varying from Cinderella's castle to the Rockin' Roller Coaster. There are even some princesses and beloved Disney characters floating around. DECA Inc provides several ticketing options for this as well.

Disney Springs

- Disney Springs is a great option if your chapter is looking for the Disney experience without purchasing a ticket. This area is home to countless shops and restaurants, including the famous Rainforest Cafe. Disney Springs is open until midnight and there is no entry cost, so it is a great way to spend some time without spending money!

Gatorland

- ICON Orlando is a 400 foot tall giant observation wheel in the middle of Orlando, providing riders with an incredible view of the whole city! The wheel has only been in Orlando since 2015 and was originally known as the Coca-Cola Orlando Eye. Tickets for this are also available through several websites.
